

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: 2010 Army Acquisition Review

1. I have reviewed and fully support the overall blueprint for acquisition reform articulated in the Final Report of the 2010 Army Acquisition Review, co-chaired by the Honorable Gilbert F. Decker and General (Retired) Louis C. Wagner, Jr. After discussions with the Army Acquisition Executive, I have decided to implement 63 of the review's recommendations. While six of these require action outside the Army, the remaining 57 can be implemented by the Army alone. Accordingly, I have determined that we will adopt those 57 recommendations once detailed implementation plans have been developed and approved by me. Furthermore, we will work with stakeholders outside the Army to address the six recommendations affecting more than just Army equities.
2. Because implementation of these recommendations cuts across multiple functional domains, I have directed the Deputy Under Secretary of the Army (DUSA) to manage and oversee this effort. He will be assigning recommendations and actions to various Army organizations, which will be tracked by the Director of the Army Staff (enclosure). Advise the Executive Communications and Control Office immediately should you believe either that the "lead" for an issue should be reassigned because the matter is more properly encompassed in the functions or responsibilities of another Army official or that other officials should coordinate or assist on a particular matter. Consult with the DUSA if there are additional issues that should be added, restated or eliminated.
3. I retain final approval authority for each individual matter set forth by the report. I expect that each Headquarters, Department of the Army Principal Official or organization assigned as "lead" for each of the tasks or issues will coordinate among all equity holders and that I will be provided a fully staffed resolution for each of those issues.
4. The DUSA will conduct regular In-Progress Reviews and report to me when all 63 of the recommendations have been implemented. Point of contact in the Office of the DUSA is Mr. Mark Von Heeringen, (703) 695-8375.
